Pacific Coast Container (PCC) partners with Trinium Technologies to upgrade systems for its West Coast container freight stations

Pacific Coast Container (PCC) signed a long-term agreement with Trinium Technologies to implement the Trinium Enterprise suite of transportation and logistics software applications across its various business units. PCC operates container freight stations and transload/crossdock facilities along the West Coast, which cater to the import/export trade. PCC also operates a trucking company in Oakland under the name Direct Delivery.

Trinium is replacing a legacy system that was developed in-house at PCC, which the company had outgrown. PCC will use the Trinium transportation, warehousing, distribution, and CFS products, which are all integrated under a single database.

The Trinium-TMS product is already "live" in Oakland managing Direct Delivery's harbor drayage business. Trinium-CFS is "live" in Los Angeles managing PCC's container freight station operations. Trinium-WMS will be used to manage inventories for public warehousing facilities, and Trinium-DMS will be used for transload/crossdock operations.

"There are very few software vendors that match Trinium's broad scope of functionality, especially in the international logistics market. Their system provides integrated functionality with the capability to manage multiple sites with a centrally deployed database," said Abdel Zaharan, Pacific Coast Container's CFO.

PCC expects to streamline its internal operations and reduce costs by automating its processes enterprise wide. Customer service levels are also improving as customers now have faster, easier access to information via email, fax, EDI, XML, and the Internet.

Pacific Coast Container, Inc. is a full service container freight station (CFS) with primary emphasis on temperature sensitive cargoes such as meat, poultry and produce.
